If feeding a grain ration at a rate of 0.5 lb per 100 lb of body weight per day or more, divide total amount into 2 or 3 individual meals offered over 10 to 12 hours. Avoid abrupt changes in feed or forage type. Implement any changes to the diet over a 7- to 10-day transitional period. Changes in the amount of a grain ration should not exceed 1.0 to 1.5 lb per day. Provide free-choice access to clean, fresh water and salt at all times. Store feed in a dry area protected from insects and rodents.
